

Testing Certification:

At AdvancingBio™ we believe each donation from our screened, volunteer, allogeneic donors should be rigorously tested to ensure a high level of safety and assurance for both the physician performing the transplantation and the patient being treated. Immediately below is a comprehensive list of the tests completed on the donation that you have received. All fecal microbiota transplantation products sent from AdvancingBio™ have been tested and found to be negative, non-reactive, not detected, and/or not isolated (as applicable) for the following:

SERUM TESTING

- Anti-HIV 1/2
- Anti-HCV
- HBsAg
- Anti-HBc
- Anti-Hepatitis A (IgM)
- Anti-HTLV I/II
- Syphilis (*T. pallidum* w/reflex to RPR)
- HIV RNA
- HCV RNA
- HBV DNA
- WNV
- Chagas
- *Strongyloides* antibody (IgG)

STOOL TESTING

- *Clostridium difficile* Toxins A and B/Glutamate dehydrogenase (GDH) screen
- Stool Routine Culture to include:
 - *Salmonella*
 - *Shigella*
 - *Campylobacter*
 - *Aeromonas*
 - *Plesiomonas*
- *Vibrio* Culture
- *Yersinia* Culture
- *Escherichia coli* 0157 Culture
- *Giardia* and *Cryptosporidium* Antigen Panel
- Ova and Parasite - Comprehensive with Coccidia Evaluation:
 - Concentration to recover protozoan cysts, coccidian cysts, helminth, eggs and larvae
 - Trichrome stained smear to identify intestinal protozoa
 - Modified Acid Fast Stain to identify *Cryptosporidium* and *Cyclospora*
 - Modified Trichrome Stain to identify *Microsporidia*

Thawing Instructions:

The thawing instructions have been validated at AdvancingBio™. They are provided as examples of thawing protocol(s) that could be used in your facility.

250 mL	Method	Thaw Time
	Room temperature	6 hours
	Warm bath (30-37°C)	1 hour
	In refrigerator (4°C)	24 hours
50 mL	Method	Thaw Time
	Room temperature	2.5 hours
	Warm bath (30-37°C)	45 minutes
	In refrigerator (4°C)	24 hours

Examine product after thawing by gently swirling the bottle. Complete thawing is indicated by uniform consistency of the product with no evidence of frozen lumps.

Adverse Event Reporting:

Although rare, adverse events have been reported while performing fecal microbiota transplantation. Investigating these rare events is of prime concern to the AdvancingBio™ medical team.
